

Descendants of Nathaniel Jones

Several members of the Schooler family married into the Jones family when they all lived near each other in Cynthiana, Harrison County, Kentucky. Both extended families then moved together to areas near Whitestown, Boone County, Indiana. The small Jones cemetery located south of Whitestown is named for this family, although there are actually more Schoolers and Gochenours buried there than Joneses. The name of the cemetery likely comes from the fact that the earliest graves there are those of Jones family members.

Three marriages occurred in Cynthiana in the first decade of the 19th century, and they all involved Schooler siblings who married Jones siblings. Children of William Schooler (the Revolutionary War soldier) and Elizabeth Harrison married children of Evan Jones and Margaret Baker. Lewis Jones married Elizabeth Schooler in 1801, Benjamin Harrison Schooler married Margaret Ann Jones in 1802, and Charles Harrison Schooler married Temperance Jane Jones in 1809. James B Schooler, the son of Charles and Temperance, married Matilda Jones, who was his first cousin. One will note that all three of their children died in childhood.

A different Charles Harrison Schooler (son of Benjamin and Margaret) married Hannah Paige (daughter of Hannah Jones).

More About Evan Jones:

January 24, 1835: Purchased land on the southeast corner of Hunt Club and Salem Roads, near Zionsville, Boone County, Indiana.

1850: Appears in census, Boone County, Indiana (pg 158)

His estate settlement and land sale was held December 30, 1847 and stated that they had ten living children. Edward McIntosh has his death date as January 25, 1860, which matches the gravestone in Jones Cemetery and the cemetery records of Boone County, Indiana, so the date on the estate settlement must be wrong. It is possible that this refers to a different person.

More About John Burge Jones:

John moved to Harrison County, Kentucky. In 1821 he moved to Bartholomew County, Indiana, and in 1834 to Marion County, Indiana. From there he moved to Boone County, Indiana, and then to Richland County, Wisconsin.

On October 9, 1841, he gave about a half-acre of land for building the Christian Church, school buildings, and meeting grounds.

In 1834, Allen and Margaret moved from Bartholomew County, Indiana to Zionsville, Boone County, Indiana. They had purchased land on October 2, 1833 at the southwest corner of Cooper and Sprong Roads. They willed a lot at 415 West Pine Street in Zionsville to the Zionsville Christian Church.

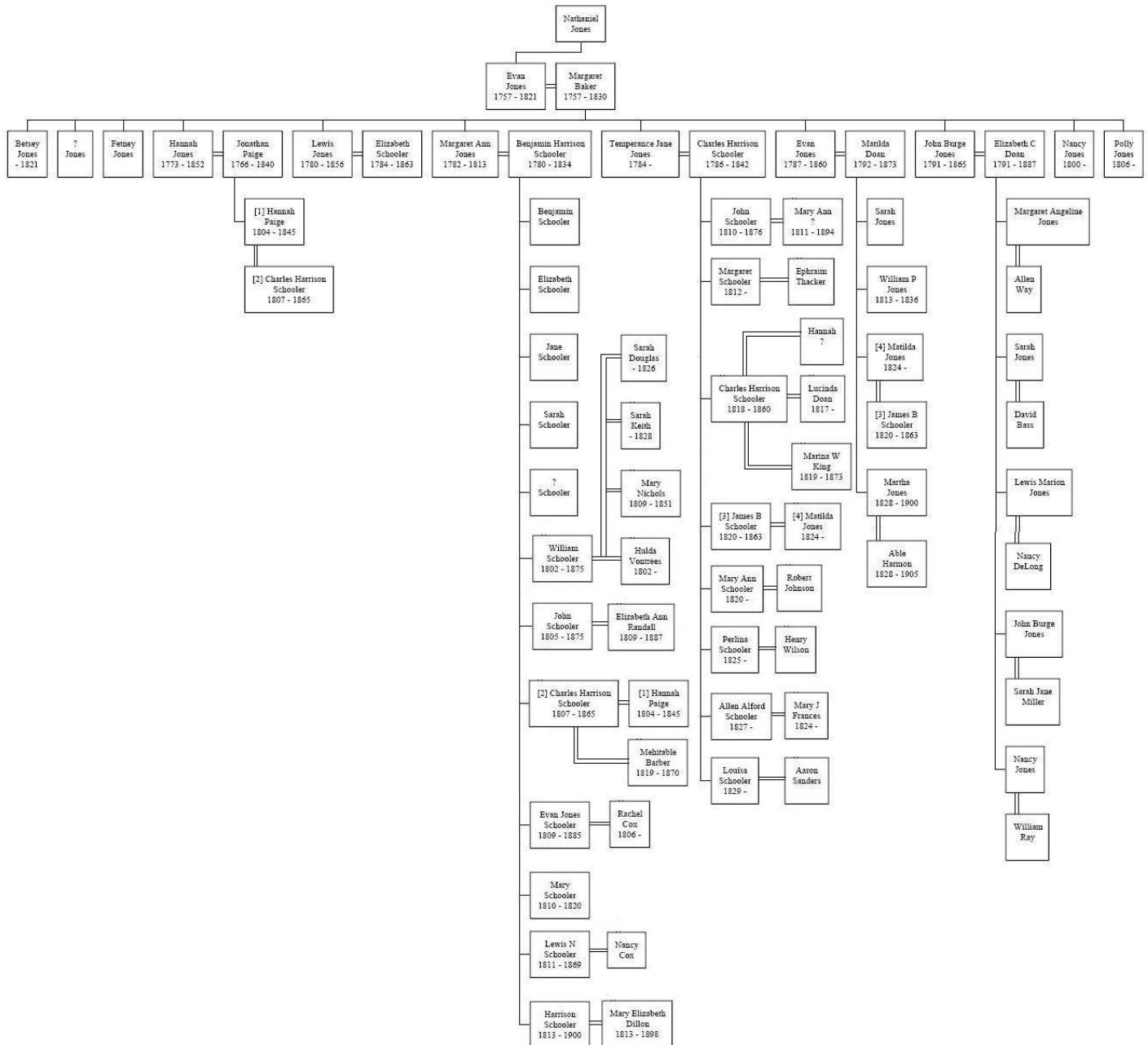
