

## *Descendants of William Harmon*

The Harmons were an influential pioneer family in southern Boone County and northern Marion County in Indiana. Charles Butler Schooler married Olive Harmon.

A special section is included showing the line of Frederick Miller, the progenitor of William “Uncle Bill” Miller. Uncle Bill was a colorful character who was one of the first settlers in Whitestown, Boone County, Indiana. Living to age 103, *The Indianapolis Star* honored his 100th birthday in 1930 with an interview. This article provides an absorbing first-hand account of growing up on a Tennessee plantation, moving via covered wagon to Indiana, and carving a farm from the forest.

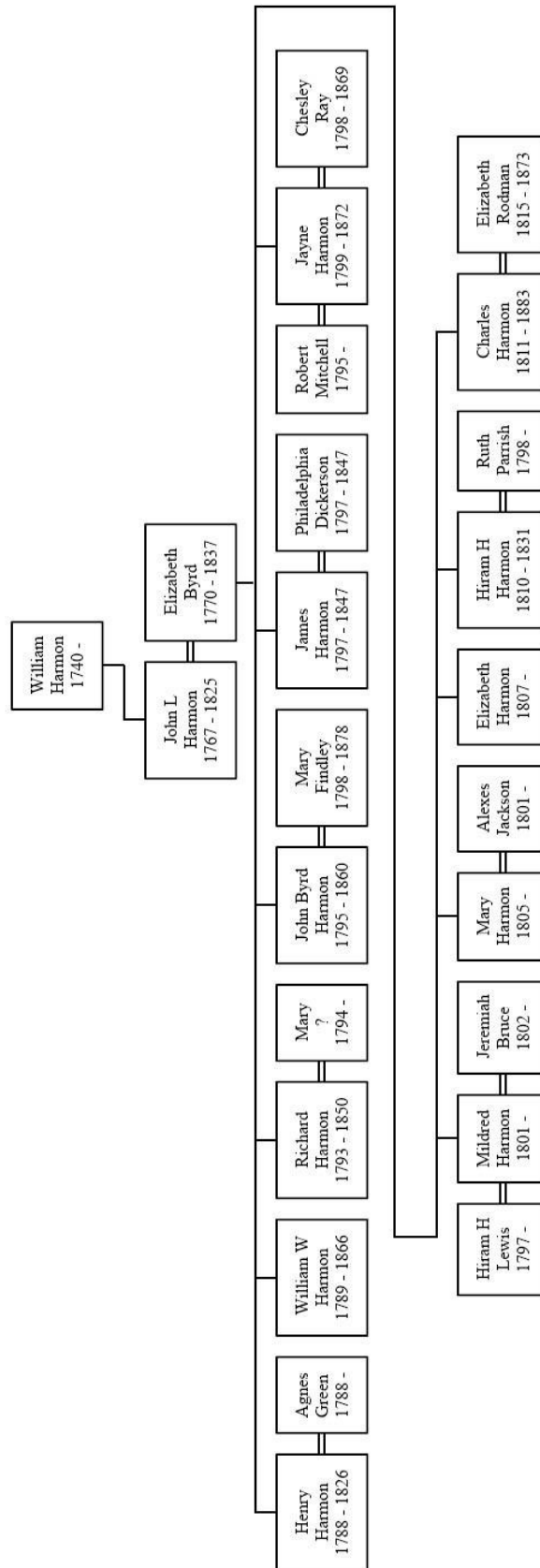

More About John Byrd Harmon:

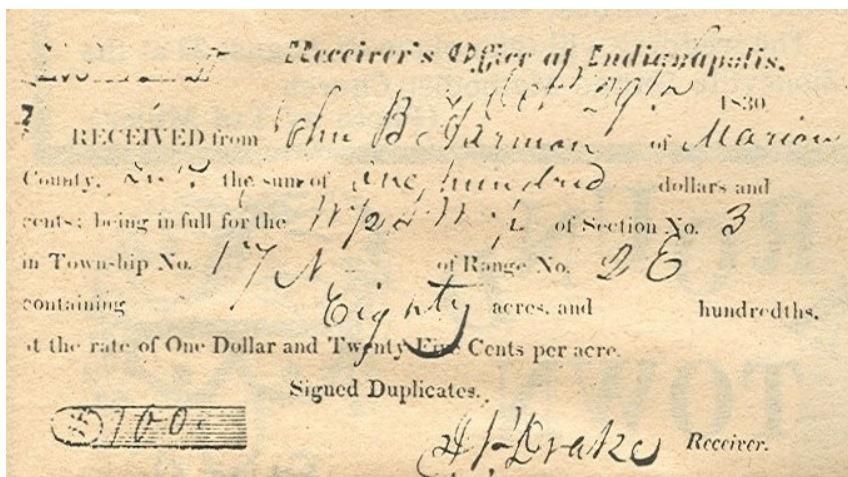
Served in the War of 1812. Enlisted at Brookville, Indiana into a Kentucky regiment under Zachary Taylor. Family tradition holds that he was a captain and that he also served in the Black Hawk War. The brass powder flask which he carried in the War of 1812 is in the possession of Keith Schooler.

1816: Moved to Jackson County, Indiana about the time of Indiana's statehood.

1820: Moved to Marion County, Indiana.

1822: Moved to Boone County, Indiana.

Between 1822 – 1835: Purchased approximately 600 acres of land in Boone and Marion Counties, Indiana. This included land south of Indiana State Road 334 and west of Salem Road, east of Cooper Road; along the north side of Hunt Club Road, and on both sides of 96<sup>th</sup> Street near Ford Road.

#### More About William S Rodman:

He was elected judge of the Boone Probate Court on August 2, 1830. Royalton, a small town in southeastern Boone County, Indiana, was originally named Rodmans. It was commissioned a post office on December 15, 1832 with William Rodman as postmaster. He purchased the land where Royalton now stands from the government on Jan 23, 1834.

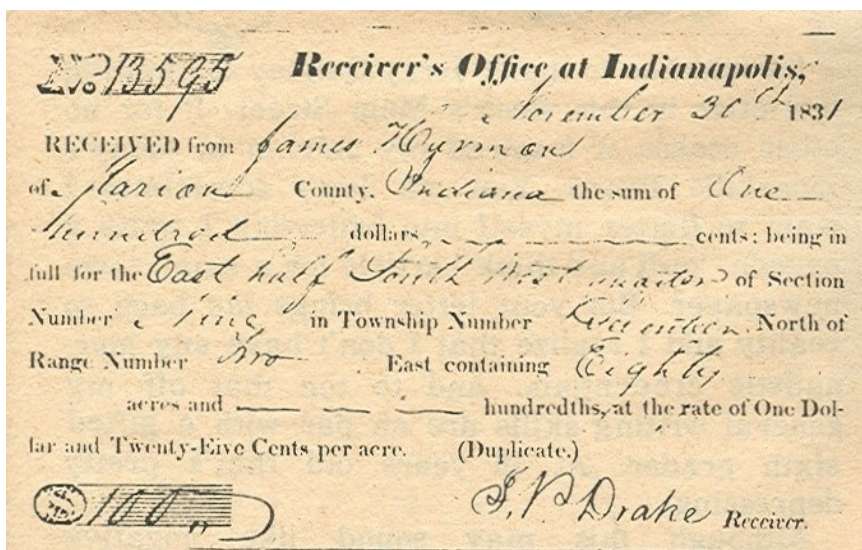

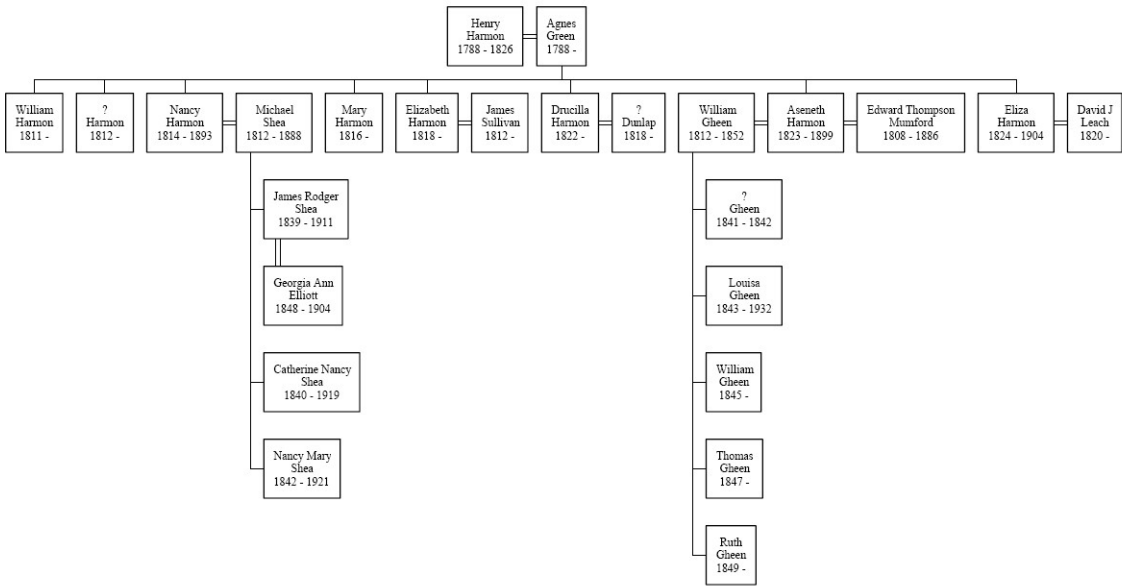

#### More About Hiram Milford Harmon:

Hiram was a farmer and lived on County Road 650 E south of County Road 650 S on the east side of the road, Eagle Township, Boone County, Indiana. He nearly lost the farm which belonged to his father, John Byrd Harmon. A warranty deed in the possession of Keith Schooler shows the sale of land at the southeast corner of Boone County (Indiana) Roads 650 E and 650 S of 15 acres to Philander Anderson, a banker in Zionsville at the time. At the time of his death, his sons Solomon and Andrew went to their mother and asked to manage the farm. Under their management they bought back much of the land. A portrait of Hiram and Marilla is in the possession of Keith Schooler.

#### More About Marilla Jane Osborn:

She was related to Solomon Oliver Osborn, an author of religious books, some of which are in the possession of Keith Schooler. He was perhaps her younger brother; they were both born in Wayne County, Indiana. He states that he was born on a farm 7 or 8 miles south of Richmond, which is the same locale as the birthplaces of the children of Jonathan, Marilla’s son. He also states that they had moved to Royalton, corresponding with the fact that Marilla moved to Boone County, Indiana when she was 18 years old.

“My father was Daniel Osborn, born on Long Island, State of New York. I was born on my father’s farm in Wayne County, Indiana, seven or eight miles south of Richmond, Oct. 19th, 1838. There were several brothers and sisters. Daniel Osborn, Jr., my eldest brother, was a successful merchant, and died a few years ago at McMinnville, Tennessee. Another brother, Zachariah Osborn, deceased, was a successful farmer of Wayne County, Indiana. I have one brother and two sisters still living. My father had been a small merchant the last few years of his life, at Royalton, Boone County, Indiana, and had some dry goods on

hand when he died.” - *Man: Body, Mind and Soul*, by Solomon O. Osborn, Cincinnati, Ohio, 1902, p. 172.

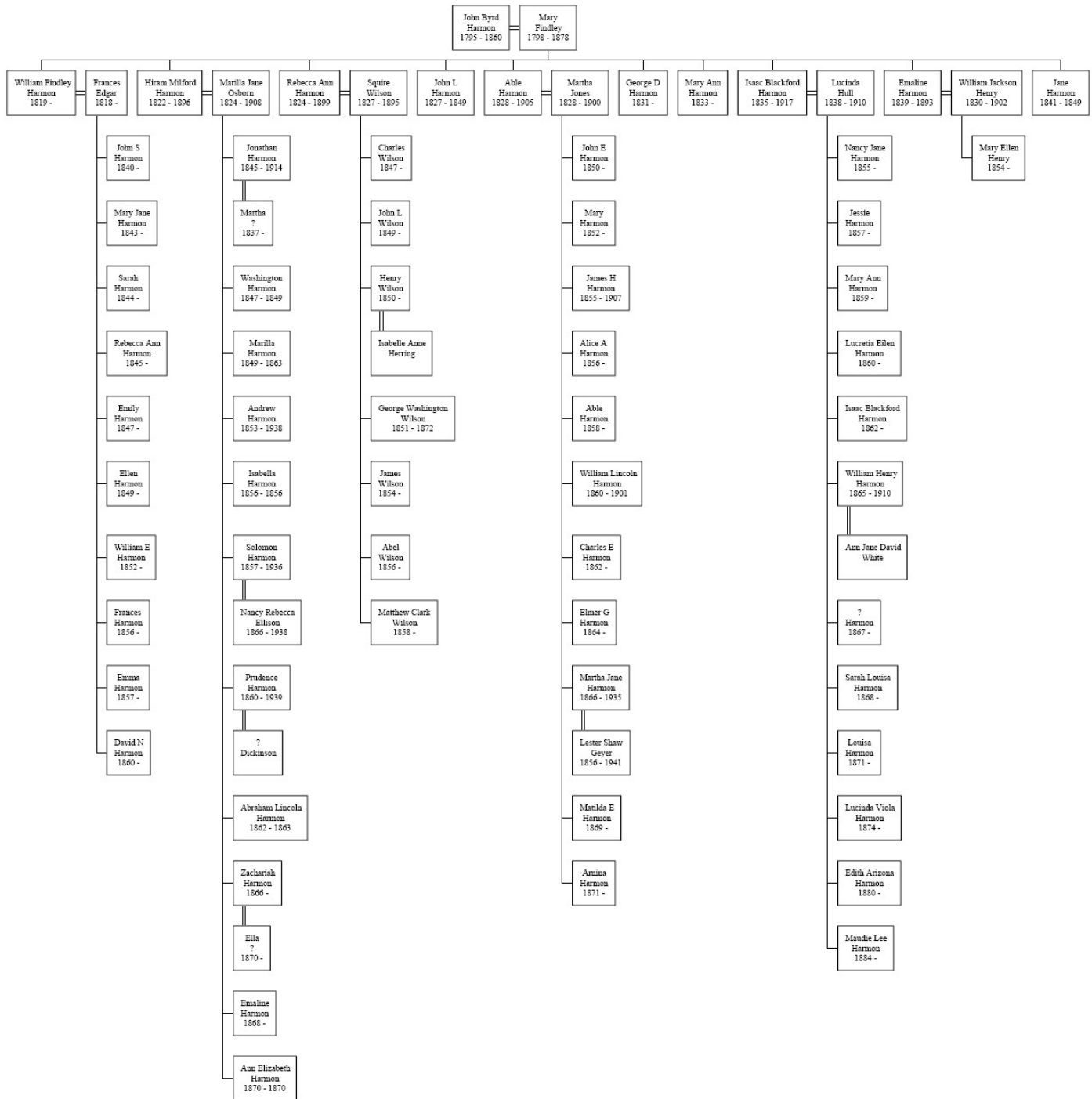

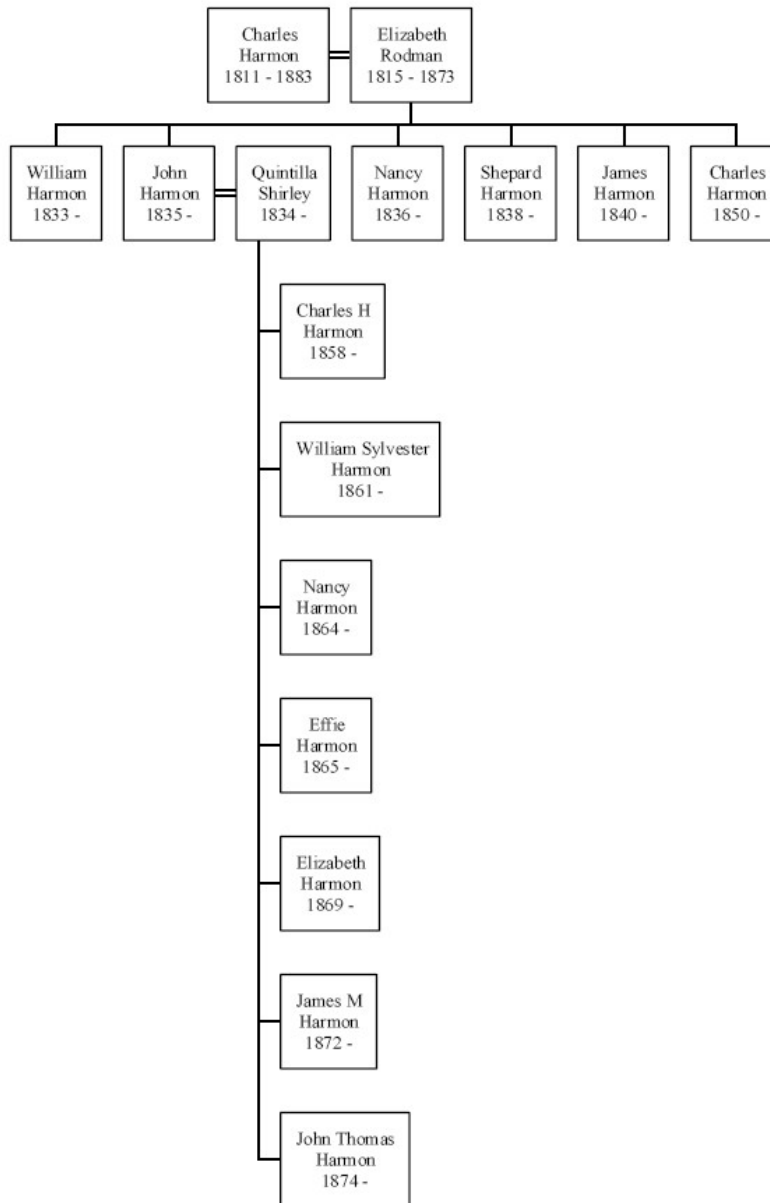

Wood, John Dickerson and Albert Wilson dug a well for Patrick Dughan last week and got plenty of water at 26 feet. Wood and Dickerson are digging one for Andrew Harmon this week.”
- “Andrew Harmon is moving his fence in from the dirt road and giving room for the new pike. People said Andy was almost sick over the defeat of his remonstrance, but he seems to be the first to get ready for the pike after all.”

Served in the War of 1812 (present at Battle of New Orleans) and the Indian Wars under General Andrew Jackson. His son William believed that General Jackson had stopped at the plantation once on a business trip to Greenville.

Charles lived near Newport, Cocke County, Tennessee and owned a 1400-acre farm on the banks of

the “Big Chucky” [Nolichucky?] River 10 miles west of Greenville, Greene County, Tennessee. He raised corn, hogs, mules and kept a few cattle. During the Civil War he went to live with his son William in Indiana for a few weeks while a battle raged over and around his farm. First the Southern and then the Northern armies swept over the old Tennessee homestead and in the end nothing was left. The house and all possessions were burned. At the end of the war he and his wife were left with only a few thousand dollars which he had hidden away. The score or so of slaves (another account indicates 40) which he had bought were gone. Two he had purchased after the outbreak of the war, paying \$2000 apiece for them. His son William commented, “Slaves were no account on a grain farm anyway. They were worthless except in the cotton fields. My father’s never earned him a dollar.”

He and his wife had 11 children.

### More About William Miller:

William was born on his father's plantation 10 miles west of Greeneville, Tennessee (see notes on father Charles Martin Miller). He was one of 11 children. He was responsible for the care and

training of a large number of horses and mules and became quite an efficient horseman. Each winter he attended a 3-month's subscription school, but the bulk of his education was obtained at home where his parents carefully schooled him and where he had access to an excellent library.

He was acquainted with Andrew Johnson, 17th President of the United States. Prior to the time that Johnson opened a tailor's shop in Greenville, Tennessee, William had worn only homespun clothes. He became interested in the new tailor and after much pleading his parents gave him enough money to buy some cloth from Johnson who cut and fit it. His mother then sewed it together.

On December 24, 1850 he married Rachel Ottinger, a sister of Jacob Ottinger, who once lived in Worth Township, Boone County, Indiana. They eagerly awaited an opportunity to go to Indiana. In their neighborhood lived Lewis Harmon, whose brother, Bill Harmon, had located in Boone County near where the Lutheran Cemetery is located. The Lewis Harmons, William and his wife and their 5-month-old baby Sarah, brother Charles Miller, and another brother made the trip. They rigged up a large linen-covered wagon and 3 horses for the 11-day trip. They came by way of Milton, Kentucky and took a steamboat ferry across the Ohio River to Madison, Indiana. The road to Indianapolis was dirt.

Charles Miller, after "rambling around" in Indiana, Missouri, Tennessee, and Illinois, finally settled in Parke County, Indiana.

They arrived in Indianapolis in fall, 1852, where they found the main street (now Washington Street) was lined with only a few frame store buildings and many log huts. They camped overnight there, were unable to buy a loaf of bread, and compromised by purchasing some corn meal which his wife made into batter cakes at their camping place.

They then went on to the Bill Harmon farm. They stayed there only 2 nights and continued on to Clinton County where for 3 months William cut cord wood and helped in a blacksmith shop. Lewis Harmon stayed in Clinton County. They spent a year on a Carroll County farm on the old Michigan Road (now U.S. 421) near Burlington, then moved to a farm on the edge of Howard County. In 1854 they moved to Boone County, where they stayed. They did not intend to stop in Whitestown, but planned to move further west, probably to Missouri. However, they only had \$5 left, so they stayed.

He leased an 80-acre farm for 7 years north of Whitestown which was owned around 1925 by Dora Dulin. Only 5 acres was cleared, so he hewed logs and erected a dwelling, barn and corn crib. He used timber on 60 acres to make railroad ties, bridge lumber, and cord wood. About 2,000 cords of wood were cut, most of which he sold to the Big Four Railroad for use in the locomotives. He used to drive a team of oxen to Indianapolis to get his meal ground at a mill on the banks of the old canal, which took a whole day.

He saved \$975, all of which he converted into gold. Whenever he accumulated \$100 he would exchange the bills for gold, paying a premium of 25 cents. He then rented a box house on a farm west of Whitestown, owned in 1932 by Bert Essex. A short time later in 1861 he moved to the farm west of Whitestown where he stayed. (See notes on father Charles Martin Miller about Civil War.)

He cleared the 20 acres of timber in Whitestown south of the railroad and west of the north-south road. The old school, Methodist Church and elevator are now located on that site.

In 1870 his wife died after having 3 children. He remarried in 1872 to Laura Ronk, who died in 1916. They had 6 children.

He was a friend of Indiana governor Samuel M. Ralston. He employed Mr. Ralston in his Lebanon days as his attorney in the little legal business he did and visited him in the Governor's

office in the Statehouse.

In 1930 he took his first airplane ride with his son Charles I. Miller, who lived with him. On his 100th birthday he expressed such a strong desire to try it that the Ford Motor Company sent one of its tri-motored planes, piloted by Col. Reg Robbins, who took him over the route between Lebanon and Indianapolis, which he had first traveled in a covered wagon.

William was a member of the Odd Fellows Lodge and was a Jeffersonian Democrat. He was a member of Gossett's Methodist Episcopal Church.

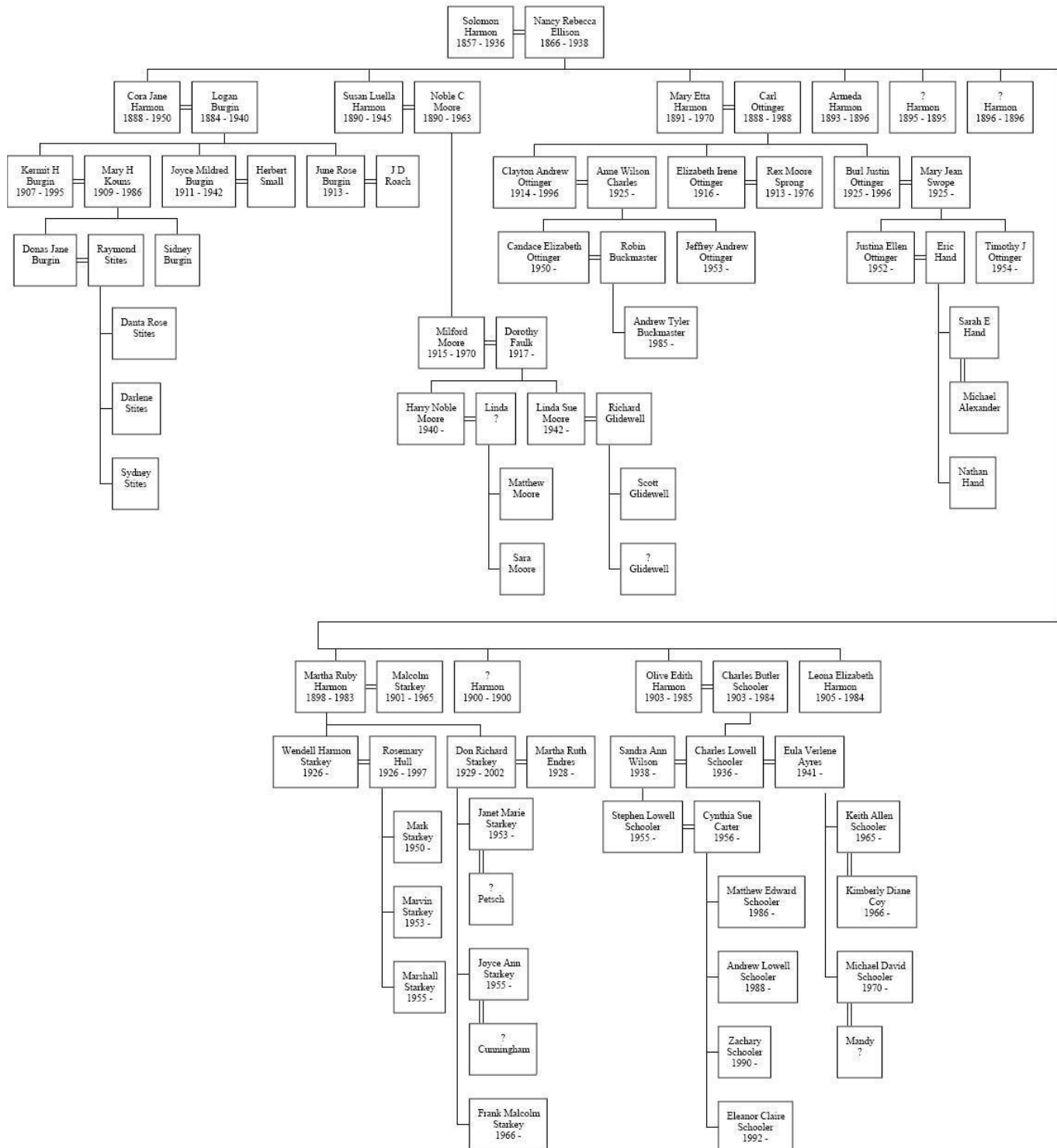
